Optional Dress Code (mufti) for Personal Practice

JPC are sponsoring a trial to evaluate suitability of mufti dress for personal practice sessions. This trial will commence at the beginning of the 2021 outdoor bowling season and will be reviewed periodically during the season.

Personal practice sessions shall not take place half an hour before or during the following events on the green:-

- Bowls England competition matches (external)
- Bowls Surrey competition matches (external)
- Ashtead Bowling Club inter club fixtures as published in fixtures booklet
- Ashtead Bowling Club inter club competitions.
- Sutton and District Bowls Association competition matches (external)
- Other Club matches as published in the fixture card.

Personal practice sessions shall not take place during formal internal club activities which require the wearing of 'bowls greys' such as:-

- Club Night,
- Ballots,
- Ladies Evening,
- Men's Evening

If you wish to practice on an available rink then please use the same dress code level being observed in the club activity.

Personal Practice Sessions may otherwise be held when no formal external, internal club activities or formal club sessions including competitions are being conducted. At which time casual dress (mufti) may be used providing correct bowls footwear is used and with the following clothing exceptions:-

- No ripped, torn or obviously dirty clothing.
- No cargo or combat style clothing, no track suits,
- No clothing with prominent or offensive slogans,
- No clothing exposing midribs or underwear.
